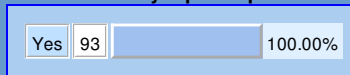

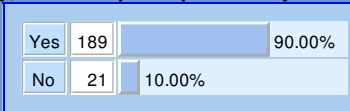

-Currently a participant?



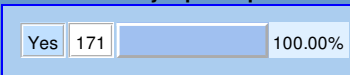
### Question 5\*

Have you been, or are you presently, an active participant in any online portion of the vampire community?



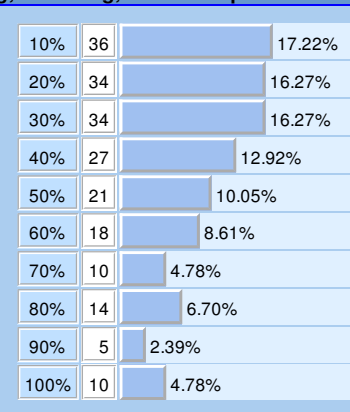

### Briefly, why do you feel this way?

ive no idea who the elders are but everyone ive asked help from have been very nice and helped me through my awakening

An elder could be someone that has been in the community for a long time or it could be an older person that just appoints themselves as an elder without having any prior experience. It all depends on the situation and the person/s involved.

I would have to select neutral because it absolutely depends upon the individual rather than the collective.

There are some who have taken advantage of others and abused their trust, and there are some who live up to their responsibilities to to the community.

Depends if the even fit the term; how long they have been i the community and what they have done for others during that time. Elder is a very loaded term...

They tend to be set in their ways for one, the tend to exclude new arrivals instead of make attempts at teaching and many are just plain rude

I've personally found that for every good 'Elder' that I find, there's at least one bad 'Elder' to counterbalance them, if not completely overshadow them. And, frankly, because I hate watching 'Elders' sit and argue the validity of various forms of vampirism - some are of the opinion that only science has the answer like good atheistic nazi's, and others are convinced we should feed from rocks and sprinklers like the idiotic new age hippies the atheist nazi side claims. When in infighting, religious posturing (be it theistic or a-theistic) and "my vampirism is real-er than yours" attitudes die, I'll revise my opinion. It depends. Some who consider themselves "elders" think they're the end.all of vamp knowledge. Others are simply those who have been around for a bit & have some experience (& aren't wankers about it)

A good elder is a worthy advisor. But like any advisor the wise one also can give false advice. A bad elder is indeed trouble.
I'm independent. I've seen "elders" around but never had real interactions.
I say neutral, because I have gone both ways with this. Some of them have a very elitist view which I disapprove of, while others are extremely helpful to the newly awakened.
No one can prove the age of one's soul, though I will bow to those with more experience in this lifetime.
Elder in my mind refers to someone with a lifetime of knowledge. I can pretty accurately say that most that call themselves "elders" are still learning like the rest of us.
It's just a label. Even if an inaccurate term. I see a select few as "elders" but not in any sense of leadership as in lording over anyone or anything.. I see it simply as they're more experienced and have accomplished some positive things for the community.
They have a better understanding of what it means to be a vampire and how to live as one in a way that is better for the greater good.
Most of those that I would consider an "elder" would never allow others to call them such. Most that call themselves and elder are full of hot air much of the time.
They have done nothing to gain this title, they don't deserve it.
Others name them elders because of how long they have been involved with the community and how much they have done to help pave the way to the state we are in now. I respect their experiences and amounts of time put in.
These so called "Elders" I personally believe that people who call them selves elders just think highly of themselves compared to those who truly are highly respected in the VC that are truly known as elders

I think Elder is a title one earns by the respect of others and you're own time involved with your own household, court, or local vampire community. I would never call myself an elder, but I have been active in the VC since 1998
labels showing a hierarchy are kinda flawed, the title feeds the ego too much, but having respected members of a community surrounding something so outcast and little-proven, present and available to educate others that happen to be less experienced or more confused about said obscure subject. I would say any similar could value mentors, whether you call them teachers, elders, mentors, or role models.
i have always needed to draw energy from others to sustain my well being as well as health
A lot of the time these people are highly egotistical and talk down to you and feel like they are superior to you. I have only had one good experience with someone in this role
Most of he ones I have encountered has been polite and helpful.
You should never refer to yourself as an Elder. That is a position that is self-evident and revealed through action and wisdom. Those who claim it rarely are.
I would say they are people. None of them are positive all the time and none of them are negative all the time. Also whether they are positive or negative is highly dependent on whether the person you are asking likes them or not.

In my experience, few people referred to themselves as "elders". Those that did have been in the VC for a bit, but since I've no way of knowing HOW LONG they've been there it doesn't matter. Nor, does that title mean anything to me. Except that they aren't Twilight lovers, which I generally dislike for their beliefs concerning the VC.
most of those "Elders" are not elders.
Depends on the individual. Some are fantastic and very supportive, others are obviously very busy and only talk about themselves.
There is much too much vagueness about why certain people should be regarded this way, there is no clear definition of an elder and certain of these "elders" engage in the very behaviour that they proclaim themselves to be against.
alison is a bitch and no one likes her everyone just wants her out of the community
I feel that most of them are "acting the part" without the real experience and knowledge to back it up. A true leader does not need to boast his or her title.
those I have had contact with are intelligent people with quick thoughts and gentle minds, for the most part.
They are often experienced and have done things that have helped either the community itself or individual VC members.
I believe that the use of the word elder often times does not mean "time spent" in the community but more a self imposed title to make them look important to others. While I do agree that there are legitimate 'elders' in the community, the word is being abused by many.
everyone ive met has been nice except lady slinky from vcmb forum and memory from ddd forum
Extraordinary claims require extraordinary proof.

They are long standing members of the vampire community and do deserve recognition. But whether elder is the right term, or gives the right impression I'm not sure.

I am 54 yrs of age. I have known real elders (of age 15-20 yrs in the community). I see now a days fledgelings of the age of 13+ calling themselves elders but they are just children with big egos.

what one sees online and what one see's when face to face with an individual is very different. i reserve my opinions until said time as i meet said "elders" in person.

For the most part, the elders I've encountered seem to want to encourage those who are newly awakened, and to share their experience. There are few notable exceptions.

I feel that some Elders tend to belittle others in various ways if the individual does not conform to the Elders expectations forgetting that everyone is different and may have their own approach for dealing with their condition.

I don't personally know any but I'm only 24 so that may be why.

Because the term means different things to various groups. It can mean older vampirics or a governing situation but to me it never means someone who has had many past lives as a vampire.

Steve has instructed me.

Big bullshit, as far as I know in real vampire community in my area we have no elders. Maybe more experienced, but age doesn't mean they're better or stronger

I doubt them. Show me why and then you will have my respect. Other than that I assume youre a pompous fake. I've met an elder in the past and they are few and far in between. That, and he didn't have to tell you he was an elder, you would know just by his energy. It was a silent, take you aback, kind of circumstance.

I had a bad run in with a so called elder in new orleans in 2010 after mardis gras. He refused to listen to my donor at the time who was raped by one of his council buddies. Instead of calling the cops on the rapist or kicking him off the council this elder told us we were lying and to leave the french quarter if we wanted to be safe.

It seems to me that most of the time, these titles are used to stake a claim of power in a dwindling pool of influence. Titles mean little compared to actions. When you see 'elders' squabbling over issues like toddlers in a sandbox, it proves it.

I believe that those who think they are Elders tend to believe that they "run things", and generally look down upon newer groups. (in my opinion)

how do you define an elder?

Some elders have been incredibly helpful, respectful and knowledgeable. Others have been rude, elitist and wishy-washy.

Don't know about everyone who thinks they're an elder.

I consider myself an Elder, and I feel my peers can be negative or positive. 50/50 on that.

Everyone has faults and I may not agree with them or they with me. I respect most in the community though.

i don't call them elders but look at them as leaders and i owe them everything i am as a vampire.

Really this depends on the elder. I would trust some with my life and others not with my cat! Its not fair to blanket all of them as good or bad.

Most of them are decent folks doing their best to help others.

Most elders are uppity and trying to preach. Unfortunately what works for one does not work for all. I've been part of the ovc for over ten years and am not an elder by a long shot.

Most that I know or are in contact with truely want to see & have a better community and how we are precieved.

Depending on the group, some are down to earth and willing to talk and share, where some want to come across as elite, and quite frankly, full of themselves.

They're good people and there are some that are young and confused. The elders help them through it not matter how stubborn or irritating the young vampire may be.

The young needs guidance from the elders

I begged for help from Lady Darkrose a few months ago and was flat out ignored. Now I know why! She was part of the same sex cult that hurt me and now she runs her own somewhere in Pennsylvania. Last year I was part of an energy workshop at the house Kheperu circle in Ohio. I was asked to remove my clothes and was then blindfolded while the others in the room touched and breathed on me. It was creepy! They really screwed around with my senses and the last thing I remember is waking up naked in my bed at home with purple bruises around my ankles and near my lower back. I'm still shaken up over what happened! Lady Darkrose and Michele Belanger are dangerous manipulators of women!

i feel some of them are only in that position because it gives them a sense of power and control

It has always been my understanding that anyone who takes the title of "elder" for himself does not deserve it simply because it is a title that is GIVEN and EARNED by others. Often times, those who exhibit "elder" traits are those who go without the title; on the opposite side of that coin, those who refer to themselves as "elders" often fall short and are undeserving of the title. In either case, I personally view these people with indifference until they exhibit some sort of trait that merits my reverence or scorn.

They've always been nice and helpful.

They helped me set up a meeting with other vampires in my hometown. I'd be still looking without them.

Have had no reason to feel otherwise

The Elders were the ones who came before, they are our foundation. I believe they are essential as teachers and guides to the Preternatural Culture.

Not everyone who has the title elder,is what I feel a elder should be or do to help the community. Elders should be hands on with newbies and be a positive influence in all they do.

The real elders of this community have been dead inside for a while.

As with all people, some are great some are not.

they keep us safe

well, they mainly seem to be out too help the next generation. and when needing answers they will try to help if they can.

Elders? that doesn't even make sense. this is a medical condition not a social hierarchic.

People with experience should be identified in some manner so that those with questions can have someone to talk to, however, those who identify themselves as elders should be careful as to how they present themselves in public since this can reflect on the community as a whole.

Some refer to themselves as elders without having real evidence of being such or they tend to act as a child would, or have no real wisdom regarding their own community. Some deserve the title because they have spent years of tireless research and searching to understand more about themselves before they tried to help others 'like' them.

With a few exceptions, the elders in the community have shown by their words and actions to want to educate the vampire community and to provide a safe haven for us.

i have met some elders that are negative and some that are positive so i am neutral on this topic

i believe that there should always be someone there to help others along on their journey, and that having a guide and some one to ask questions is rather helpful.

I find that, with their self-identified age and maturity in the vampiric community, they are rather wise and helpful to "newborns" and ancients alike. I myself am an elder.

They seem to help when it's needed.

I don't mind the title; the individual is my concern.

Some are self proclaimed...others really put the time in and their efforts to become an elder, while some may have slip through the cracks...

To me it seems they carry themselves rather well. at least from what I have observed.

Many Elders disappear or hide then show up years later thinking to get involved while speaking of how bad the behavior is in the community. It is not wise to just show up and say things like "So it has begun" when you have been in hiding for years. Things have not just begun. It has been going on for years.

because they know what they are talking about

they dont seem to want to help others and call others roleplayers if they are not the same as everyone else

I've only seen two people I would ever consider using the title of elder for and they are Merticus and Michelle Belanger. The rest are just egomaniacs with their own fan clubs.

I judge people based on how I've been affected by them.

I know a couple elders who don't deserve their titles such as Father Todd, Don Henrie, Lord Raven, Lady Slinky, Lady Helen but most are very helpful and honorable.

Mostly because some "claim" to be as such; I judge only by what I learn from them as time goes by.

Alot of them practice duplicity and are complete fuck heads.

'Elders' are people who seem to get a kick (monetary or personal) out of exploiting the subculture they 'take part' in. Whether it's selling books or candles, maintaining authoritative positions, injecting religious dogma poorly shrouded in pseudo-scientific terms, they generally have something superficial to sell to anyone dumb enough to buy it. They often discourage others from pursuing medical questions (physical or mental) and will decry anything scientifically explainable as 'fake', all while pushing product for various price ranges. At absolute best they are very insecure individuals whose attempts to rally a following are based upon the need to have others prop up their own beliefs about themselves.

They're full of shit. I've yet to meet a vampire in the real world who lived up to their online hype. Always ALWAYS a disappointment.

I respect a few of them, many seem to have beliefs that they like to present as fact. The ratio of leaders I respect vs those I don't respect is about equal to the ratio of participants I respect vs those I don't respect. It isn't because they are leaders, its mainly because a large portion of the community is full of shit.

Labels don't carry much value compared to the actual actions and assistance one is willing to give.

I never meet a true elder who actually referred to them self as an elder all of the ones who are usually say that the community has called them that when one defines themselves right out as one its most likely they are self proclaimed.

I feel most elders are neutral because they gained respect through appropriate behavior and attitude combined with experience with their vampiric nature.

From direct interactions with the community's elders I have found many, if not all, to be clear, level-headed, extremely rational people interested in the best for the VC

I don't care about the term "elder(s)." And I don't care who is an "elder" in any community. There are those worthy of my respect, and those not. If someone is respected, or not, then that is their own status.

It is not those who identify themselves as leaders/elders, it is those who identify others to those titles because they feel those members have earned the right out of time spend and things done.

It depends who is proclaiming the title

What makes them elders?...if we are all the same, Vampyres, why treat others differently...why have a class system...Are Elders more important than me??

I only believe in the authority of Runa Enustas Caoille of the Grave Dollz Society and true wolf vampire hybrids as the ruling elder party.

I don't see the point of anyone putting themselves above anyone else.

most choose to teach younger ones but there are a few that strive only to further their own power

I'm neutral because though they are important to teach people who are new...I dont think they are absolutely vital because ultimately people can find

truth for themselves. I sort of feel like it starts a unnecessary hierarchy.

I only regard to a few people as elders and those are people that have earned the title (myself not included)funny thing is those that make you regard to them as elders are not the ones I would name.

I really could care less what people call themselves, or what others call them. If they have earned respect, they shall have it. If they have not earned respect, they will not have it, regardless of tittle.

Unfortunately, the majority who declare themselves "elders" have no more right of leadership over the community than anyone else in the community. They are just, for the majority, power hungry individuals who offer hollow words to attempt to satiate the need of the community's want for real organization and real leadership.

Feels like they think they are better than the others and that they are not respectful to the people that are below them.

My Elders have been very open and supportive. Answering any questions I may have.

Understanding that the definition of elder is a person who has been an active participant and respected participant in the VC for a particular time period and help others with their vampiric condition. That being said, I generally agree with the status name of 'elder' I suppose that it is the most accurate term that does not exude hierarchy or power over others. There should be a more definate way to make sure that those who are dubbed elders are worthy of its definition.

Because there aren't truly elders that have true pull in the community at large. It's far too divided for that. That needs to change but people are so sensitive and so prone to overreacting that it doesn't seem possible. It's in individual houses where you find the elders.

The vampire 'elders' who are into the kink scene are very dangerous and two faced. I've heard stories from trusted friends and seen with my own eyes after scenes were over in the club these so called 'elders' preying on younger girls just to fuck with their emotions. My girlfriend of six years was drugged in a club in the French Quarter and the 'elder' vampires stripped her of her clothes and acted out a sex ritual for spectators. She woke up in her hotel the next morning with some kind of brand on the underside of her upper arm and bruises on her sides. When she complained to the 'elder' council she was told she could either shut the fuck up or she would never be allowed into a club there again. Last year she ran into people who had horrible experiences on Fetlife and told me to stay far away from Tim Brousard, JP from Temple UVUP, Deacon Gray, Draken Blak, and the vampires who flirted with girls and wanted to meet them. Vampires may be predators but rape, teen sex, and violence is a line that shouldn't be crossed! These people disgust me!

I lost my baby girl because the moderator pricks at sanguinarus.org VCMB group turned over private chat logs I give almost four years ago to the family court. I was in a dark time and thought the people who claimed they wanted to help me had my back. I've been screwed over by my ex and his vampyre wet nurses enough for two life times. FUCK THEM ALL!!!!!!!

This question is difficult to answer. I don't think they are good or bad elders per say but more like helpful and nonhelpful elders or even groups. The most helpful groups I've found are Psychic Vampyre dot org, Atlanta Vampyre Alliance, Smoke and Mirrors, and The Vampyre Metrou. The least most helpful groups are Vampyre Forum dot net, Vampyre Community Message Board VCMB, Drink Deeply and Dream, and Vampyre Rave. Good groups need praised and bad groups need eliminated so newcomers don't find bad information.

they have an experience that i lack in this community.. i am still a young member and wish to learn. and they are the ones who i prefer to learn from

The elders I know has become weak and turned their back on the olde ways. They've let their donors has control over when they feed and set stupid conditions in the bed room. Everyone has the right to call themselves what they wish. They can only truly rank themselves. For the most part they do not affect me or my actions, thoughts or feelings.

I think people in the vamp community need to be a combination of open-minded, patience and quasi-friendly. Lording over others with your ideas or opinions isn't the way to go about it, nor is sitting by and agreeing with every opinion and theory that comes about. The community could use a lot of improvement; it's getting the people who are in the position to start those improvements that are the problem, sometimes.

I think under some groups/types of people that should be removed are Father Sebastian, Temple of vampire, Rev JP, Lilith Darkwraith and the vampire nations concord council of elders.

I think there should be a hell of a lot more of an exchange between the VC and energy working communities as a whole, wherein open minds listen to one another in trying to find possible reasons why vampires feel and act how they do; if there's a severe deficiency in production of energy, causing an insatiable desire, or whatever.

In regards to #10 and #16: Personally speaking, I think that vampirism is an energetic condition, and the only cure as of yet is through donors and the regular practice of energy work. However, I am open to the idea of it being a physical condition, which is why I added those options. It is also the reason why I think that we need to build up our principals of "logic and investigation". However, I do not think that it should be solely built on that, but rather on a few different bases, another being on bringing the community more together as a whole, rather than the disjointed groups we have scattered around the world. The Houses and Covens should be in contact with each other. The groups near each other should have meetings and, for lack of a better term, "Group Bonding". We need to know each other before we can introduce ourselves to the rest of the world.

In my experience, the newer generation of vampires are not as willing to learn from those with experience, which will make affecting any changes to the community difficult. We need to be more open to each other.

We need to focus more on finding the facts of what makes us vampires & less on metaphysical/mystic theories for a cause we can't explain yet. Lifestylers seem to be the majority of the community.
